Use an exciting visual tool called Destiny Quest, designed especially for them to use in searching for information.

Call on their librarian, and rely on Follett Destiny to help them (even with spelling!) find the right resources.

Go to AskRI.org for even more resources, including homework help, online information and life skills.

Get lessons related to state and national standards, with links to library materials, web and online resources.

Use online resources especially collected for them by their librarian and teacher for lessons and research.

Take notes, work on research, check assignments and communicate with teachers using Cognite.

Get targeted help based on test scores and evaluations.

Study and learn in an environment that meets their educational and developmental needs.

Work collaboratively in a project-based environment on topics that develop their interests.

See the covers reading levels, and summaries for the books in their library as they make their choices.

Borrow books from other libraries, through a virtual online library with delivery statewide.
