What's in a name? Library media specialists are also teachers. As teacher librarians we teach the information process, understand the uses of technology, select and use a wide variety of materials, and work in partnership with classroom teachers using books, information and technology.

Your library – what can you find, and how to get what you need

Your library's online catalog – Find it on the web by going to your school/district home page, or through our shared home page at **www.ricat.net**. Look for your school in the list of libraries, which is divided by grade level, with multi-level schools listed on the bottom right.

Click on the link for your school's library to go to the library's home page on RICAT. Your library may have a page for news, announcements, and resource links:

From the library's home page, you can click on the catalog tab to find out what the library has.

Once you have done some searches, you can see any of your previous searches by clicking on My Searches.

You can search by title, author, subject, keyword, or the name of a series. You can use [*] to search for a variety of endings, or [?] to replace a letter: for example, wom?n will search for both woman and women. Teach* will search for teach, teaching, teacher, etc. Using capital letters (or not) doesn't matter – Spain, spain, and SPAIN will all return the same search results. The search function also ignores punctuation, so you can just leave it out – arthurs surprise. If you are looking for something specific, you can try keyword searching. If you get too many results from your search, you

can qualify it, by using NOT (IN CAPITAL LETTERS) – that is, you can search for pets NOT dogs to find items that talk about other pets. To widen your search, you can use [OR]: for example, PILOT* OR AIRPL* NOT BOAT* will find items about airplanes or pilots, but will not include piloting of boats. NOTE: The catalog software ignores commonly used words, such as a, but, by, for, if, in, there, was, etc.

RICAT displays what it finds in two different ways – as a list of items that match, or by showing an index →
